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ROMANS 20 PART 1: LEGALISM "Let God Be True"

READ: Rom 2:25-3:8

"OUTWARD" CLEANLINESS:

The Jewish people had a religion of outward action, not inward attitude. They may have been moral on the outside, but what about the heart?

- JESUS' indictment of the Sadducees in MATT 23
- ▶ ISA 1:11-18 {READ}
- The Law did NOT have the power to change... it was "transient / temporal" On the surface...

2 COR 3:9-11 For if there was glory in THE MINISTRY OF CONDEMNATION - that is, THE LAW, THE MINISTRY OF RIGHTEOUSNESS [THE GOSPEL] must far exceed it in glory.

- ¹⁰ Indeed, in this case, what once had glory has come to have no glory at all, because of the glory that surpasses it.
- ¹¹ For if what was being "brought to an end, [THE LAW]" [was fading away] came with glory, much more will what is permanent have glory [THE GOSPEL]

TRUST IN RITUAL:

ROMANS: Grace & Peace to You

Rom 2:25-29 For circumcision indeed is of value F YOU obey THE LAW, but F YOU break THE LAW, vour circumcision becomes uncircumcision.

Purpose of Circumcision:

ROM 4:11 [Passion Trans] It was later that [Abraham] received the external sign of circumcision as a seal to confirm that God had already transferred his righteousness to him by faith, while he was still uncircumcised.

So now this qualifies him to become the father of all who believe among the non-Jewish people.

- ²⁶ So, IF a man who is uncircumcised keeps the precepts of THE LAW, will not his uncircumcision be regarded as [true] circumcision?
- ²⁷ Then he who is physically uncircumcised but keeps THE LAW will condemn you who have the written code AND circumcision but break THE LAW.
- ²⁸ For <u>no one is a Jew</u> who is <u>merely one outwardly</u>, nor is <u>circumcision outward</u> and physical.
 - ²⁹ But a Jew is one inwardly, and circumcision is a matter of the heart, [accomplished] by the Spirit, not by THE LETTER.

[THIS one's] praise [does NOT come] from man but from God.

- The Jews praised each other for their obedience to THE LAW, but the important thing is the "praise of God" and NOT the praise of men (ROM. 2:29).
 - Realizing the name "JEW" comes from "JUDAH" meaning "To give yourself in PRAISE," this statement takes on added meaning (GEN. 29:35; 49:8).
- > A true JEW is one who has had an *inward* spiritual experience in the heart, and not merely an outward physical operation.

ROMANS 20 PART 2: LEGALISM "Let God Be True"

ARROGANCE:

In ROMANS 3:1-8, Paul sums up the argument and refutes those "imagined JEWS" who would try to debate with him. These "opponents" had raised 6 questions. (Do these questions represent the attitude of some Members of the ROMAN CHURCH?)

Their "Arrogance" is portrayed by Paul in the "Unseen Opponents" questions. As we have seen before, Paul had a long history of dealing with the "Unbelieving Jews" and had faced numerous occasions of persecution either at their hands, or inspired by them.

QUESTION #1

Rom 3:1-8 Then what advantage has the [LAW-abiding] JEW? Or what is the value of circumcision?

PAUL'S REPLY: 2 Much in every way. To begin with, the JEWS were entrusted with the oracles of GOD.

Rom 9:4 They are Israelites, and to them belong the Adoption, the Glory, the Covenants, the Giving of THE LAW, the Worship, and the Promises. 5 To them belong the Patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Christ, who is God over all, blessed forever. Amen. (More on this later)

QUESTION #2

³ What IF some were unfaithful? Does their faithlessness nullify [Katargeo] the faithfulness of GOD?

PAUL'S REPLY: 4 By no means! Let GOD be true though everyone were a liar, as it is written... [Psa 51:4]

The full quotation is:

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Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, "That you may be <u>iustified in your words</u> and <u>prevail</u> <u>when you are judged</u>."

- Righteousness is a result of "faith" ... NOT performance
- THIS IS the record of SCRIPTURE since the first recorded act of "a sacrifice" by Abel

HEB 11:4 By faith Abel offered to God a more acceptable sacrifice than Cain, through which he was commended as righteous, God commending him by accepting his gifts.

- The "unfaithfulness of some" brings judgment upon them... NOT the faithful
- "The righteous shall LIVE by faith..."

QUESTION #3

⁵ But IF our unrighteousness serves to show the righteousness of GOD, what shall we say? That GOD is unrighteous to inflict wrath on us? (I speak in a human way - being exceedingly <u>facetious</u>.)

PAUL'S REPLY: 6 By no means! For then how could God judge the world?

- If ALL sin was accepted by God as simply a "reason to show His righteousness" then there would be NO judgment of sin... AT ALL.
- The Righteousness of God is NOT seen in "accepting our sin" but in removing it BY the placing the Judgment of SIN upon His Son... and THIS to be realized ONLY by those who Believe in Jesus Christ.

QUESTIONS #4 & 5

- ⁷ But IF through my lie GOD'S truth abounds to his glory, why am I still being condemned as a sinner?
- ⁸ And why not do evil that good may come? (as some people slanderously charge us with saying).
- > THESE may be among the "most ignorant questions ever proposed..." Rom 3:24-25 "...and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, ²⁵ whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith."
- What Paul presents is someone saying, "IF God gets glory by 'forgiving our sins and showing mercy' THEN the more we sin the more He is glorified"

PAUL'S REPLY: Their condemnation is iust. - Because: "God judges the world righteously" This hardly needs a response... BUT Paul offers it with a **Bold Rebuke**... **GOD Judges...** RIGHTEOUSLY!

What "condemnation" they receive BECAUSE of their sin IS justly given... By God

QUESTION #6

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What then? Are we JEWS any better off? [Rom 9:1-5 / 10:1-4]

PAUL'S REPLY: NO, not at all. For we have already charged that all, both JEWS and GREEKS, are <u>under sin</u>

Instead of glorifying God among the Gentiles, the JEWS were actually dishonoring God; and Paul had quoted **ISAIAH 52:5** to prove his point [vs 24].

There is ONLY one way:

- > To escape the "pending wrath of God's Judgment" and
- > To "obtain the righteousness by which we may LIVE" Now and in Eternity ...
- > HOW? Through FAITH in Jesus Christ!
